Have you ever drawn countless girl characters — cute faces and all — yet felt that the illustration somehow doesn't "click"? That sense of awkwardness may be coming from the pose. In fact, striking character illustrations follow a simple set of principles. There are only three key points:

1. Shift the body weight onto one leg
2. Angle the ribcage and pelvis in different directions
3. Create an S-curve through the body's axis

This combination forms "contrapposto," the classical pose that has been passed down since ancient Greece. Fashion models often use "contrapposto" consciously to make their poses look more elegant and visually appealing. Contrapposto is a versatile technique that can make a character look grounded, add a sense of motion, or create a relaxed, natural presence. If your poses don't look right, if your characters seem to be floating, or if they look like they're about to tip over — making use of this method will immediately resolve those issues. Master contrapposto and transform your characters into more appealing, more expressive, and truly "picture-worthy" figures.
